Penultimate crop among his best

Scat Daddy had seven juvenile stakes winners in 2017

THE LATE SCAT DADDY was a rare individual, a brilliant runner at 2 who was able to carry forward into his 3-year-old season. He proved rarer still in the breeding shed, leading the first-crop sires list in 2011 and adding a posthumous title as the leading sire of juveniles in 2017. His precociousness came from both his sire, Johannesburg (multiple champion at 2), and his dam, the unraced Love Style, a Mr. Prospector daughter of grade 1 sprinter Likeable Style.

Scat Daddy's departure at 11 in late 2015 left breeders grasping for his final foals at last year's yearling sales.

Scat Daddy, winner of the Champagne Stakes (G1) as a juvenile and the Fountain of Youth Stakes (G2) and Florida Derby (G1) at 3, stood his entire career at the Coolmore group's Ashford Stud near Versailles, Ky. He also shuttled one season to Coolmore Australia and three seasons to Haras Paso Nevado in Chile, where he was the leading sire four years running (2013-16).

Scat Daddy's stud fee dipped in North America—from an entry fee of \$30,000 to a recession-reduced \$10,000 for 2011, but it rose to \$17,500, then \$30,000, and \$35,000 before an advertised six-figure fee was announced for 2016. However, he

passed before he covered a mare that season.

His penultimate crop, headed by Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (G1T) winner Mendelssohn, earned \$3,318,789 and produced a list-topping 39 winners from 83 runners.

Mendelssohn, out of 2017 Kentucky Broodmare of the Year Leslie's Lady, was the highest-priced North American yearling of 2016, bringing a \$3 million bid from M.V. Magnier at the Keeneland September sale. Mendelssohn ran second in

Newmarket's Darley Dewhurst Stakes (G1) prior to shipping to Del Mar for the Breeders' Cup. He's being pointed toward the American classics by trainer Aidan O'Brien.

Scat Daddy had seven 2-year-old stakes winners in 2017, headed by Mendelssohn, but he was also represented by Sioux Nation, a group 2 winner in June of Royal Ascot's Norfolk Stakes and a group 1 victor in the Keeneland Phoenix Stakes in Ireland in August. In September, Seahenge won Doncaster's group 2 Howcraft Industrial Supplies Champagne Stakes (Mendelssohn was seventh) and in backto-back weekends in the U.S., Seabhac won the Sept. 30 Pilgrim Stakes (G3T) while Flameaway won Keeneland's offthe-turf Dixiana Bourbon Stakes (G3) Oct. 8.

Of note, Scat Daddy is from the Storm Cat line out of a mare by Mr. Prospector. Seahenge, Flameaway, and Seabhac all have Mr. Prospector in their female lines as does Exacta Systems Juvenile Fillies Stakes winner Ultima D.

While honored as the leading sire of juveniles, Scat Daddy was best seen during the Royal Ascot meet in England in June where he was represented by four wins from 15 starts and major victories by Lady Aurelia in the King's Stand Stakes (G1) and Caravaggio in the group 1 Commonwealth Cup.

Beyond leading the juvenile list, Scat Daddy ranks sixth on the 2017 general sires list and is second with six grade/ group 1 winners behind the seven posted by Medaglia d'Oro. Scat Daddy's chief earner, Daddys Lil Darling, won the American Oaks (G1T) at Santa Anita Dec. 30. Scat Daddy's 27 black-type stakes winners on the year were tops in North America.

With his final crop of yearlings making their way through the sale ring in 2017, Scat Daddy was a popular play. He had 71 yearlings sell last year for an average
